- School 6th Form – variety of subjects on offer including BTECs and A levels within a school environment.
- College - there are several colleges in and around Derbyshire and Nottingham. They offer courses to suit all abilities. You could choose to do a course to get you ready for a specific job such as motor vehicle or childcare. Alternatively, you could go down the academic route and study general subjects such as A levels or you could study T-Levels.
- Apprenticeship - combines on-the-job training with study. It is a way of training for a trade or profession. You learn, work towards qualifications, gain work experience and get paid. Apprenticeships are available across a wide range of industry sectors. These include business administration, ICT, motor vehicle, engineering, childcare and hairdressing.
